#### **DUTIES:**

Successful candidate will among other things perform the following duties:

- Assist the Procurement Specialist in the implementation of procurement procedures for the program in accordance with AfDB and CGIAR requirements, as applicable;
- Prepare a Program Procurement Plan that includes the focus value chains and Enablers in close consultation with Value chain and Enabler leaders;
- Prepare and update the Value chains' annual procurement plans to be included in the program's quarterly and annual work plans and budgets;
- Prepare relevant inputs to standard bidding documents, such as TORs, specifications and Bills of Quantities;
- Participates in the bidding/tendering processes for the procurement of works, goods and services following AfDB and CG procurement rules and procedures as applicable;
- Collate all program technical quarterly and annual reports from the different value chains and Enablers for review and submission to the Bank;
- Assist with the organization of program management meetings and AfDB supervision missions, including the preparation of all materials required for such meetings;

- Prepare all procurement records to facilitate post-procurement reviews during supervision missions;
- Keep and maintain up-to-date procurement records in line with AfDB requirements;
- Carry out any other activities assigned by the Procurement Specialist or the Head of the Project Management Unit.

# **QUALIFICATION:**

Minimum of BSc/HND in Public or Business Administration, or Accounting/Finance or related field from a recognized university with proven track record and/or specialized training in procurement with a minimum of five (5) years' experience as a procurement officer in a multilateral donor funded project or program with a procurement authority.

- Demonstrate ability to plan and co-ordinate, and monitor own work plans, including meeting of set deadlines.
- Be self-motivated with ability to work under minimum supervision.
