# **Position: Lead Anthropometrist**

#### **DUTIES:**

- Explain clearly the anthropometry procedures and measurements to be taken, the role of the caretaker and what is expected of the caretaker and child(ren).
- Take length/height and weight measurements.
- Complete the required questionnaires and forms as set out in the CAPI, including how to determine the date of birth of the child properly.
- Maintain and calibrate the equipment and report any issues immediately to the field supervisor.

# **QUALIFICATION:**

Bachelor degree in medicine, medical laboratory science/technology. An employee of state or federal government with above qualifications can also apply and must have a current practice license.
