In line with this agreement IITA seeks a highly qualified and experienced Cassava Extension Agronomist.

Position Responsibilities:

- Contribute to the implementation of the National Cassava Development Strategy in Liberia in conformity with the SAPEC Work Plan.
- Train staff of the SAPEC Project, MOA, and NGOs on cassava value chain analysis.
- Provide technical assistance on postharvest technologies to the Ministry of Agriculture (MOA), NGOs, cassava processors, and other private sector actors in SAPEC Project counties.
- Introduce, validate, disseminate and promote improved cassava postharvest technology options.
- Provide technical support to the operation of existing Cassava Technology Training Centers (TTCs) in the SAPEC Project counties.
- Introduce and adapt cassava processing equipment (e.g. peeler, grater, chippers, presser, and dryer).
- Train local artisans in adaptation, repair, and maintenance of processing equipment.
- Provide technical assistance to the establishment and operation of micro-processing and market centers, including marketing strategies (pricing, packaging, collecting, etc) in the 12 SAPEC Project counties.

Educational Qualifications

The candidate should have a PhD in Extension Agronomy and significant field experience in farm level research, technology extension, multilocational testing, and farmer technology adoption processes.

Core Competencies

- Good knowledge of Cassava value chains.
- Applied knowledge in production of planting materials of cassava varieties.
- Experience in working with informal and formal sectors in dissemination of improved cultivars.
- Experience in field experimentation, trial management and quality control of planting materials as well as familiarity in variety release procedures and seed/planting material regulations.
- Excellent communication, leadership, interpersonal, and team building skills as well as ability to teach.

- Experience with project activity implementation and monitoring.
- Excellent spoken and written English.
- Demonstrated success in working with multi-disciplinary and multi-institutional teams and partnerships in a cross-cultural environment.
- Excellent social skills, a collaborative style, proactive and innovative attitudes.
- Willingness to travel extensively within Liberia.
- Capacity for planning and organizing as well as analyzing and resolving problems.
- Experience working with national partners in Africa will be an asset.
